CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is:

Cadet Instructors Cadre Branch Association of British Columbia (CIC BA BC)

2. The purpose(s) of the society is (are):

- a. To provide Cadet Instructors Cadre (CIC) personnel in British Columbia (BC) with social opportunities to meet, network, communicate, and share ideas;
- b. To provide CIC personnel in BC with professional development opportunities not offered by the Regional Cadet Instructor School (Pacific);
- c. To further the professional standing and esprit de corps of CIC personnel in BC;
- d. To assist with the management and operation of the Pacific Region CIC Bursary and Kit Shop as required;
- e. To make recommendations to the CIC Regional Advisory Council (RAC) and Commanding Officer, Regional Cadet Support Unit (Pacific), on issues that arise that are outside of the CIC BA BC's control; and,
- f. To undertake any other initiatives which benefit CIC personnel in BC.
