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116/16 – RCSU (PAC) PERSONNEL CHANGES

1. The following personnel changes have occurred at RCSU (Pac):

2. The following personnel changes are corrected from the RO entry 102/16:

117/16 – RE-EMPHASIZED REQUIREMENT – COMPLETION OF POSITIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AND PROGRAM OUTREACH

1. The requirement still exists for all CCO adult leaders (COATS members, CIs, Public Service employees, volunteers and League members) to complete the Positive Youth Development and Program Outreach (PYDPO) learning package. The package is available through the Defence Learning Network (DLN) and, in the case of League members and volunteers, distributed via CD and administered by the respective Leagues.

2. As of the initial completion deadline of 31 March 2016, only 60% of active CCO adult leaders had completed the required training.
3. Although this deadline has passed, the mandatory requirement for all CCO adult leaders involved in the Cadet and JCR programs to complete the PYDPO package remains and this requirement is re-emphasized.
4. Therefore, the deadline for completion of this package has been extended by the A/DComd Natl CJCR Sp Gp to 31 August 2016 for all members who were enrolled, employed or initiated voluntary service prior to 1 April 2016.
5. Adult leaders who commenced involvement with the CCO on 1 April 2016 or after are required to complete the package not later than 31 December 2016.
6. Class "A" members (COATS and CIs) who complete the package through the DLN prior to the expiry date of the new deadlines outlined in paragraphs 4 and 5 are authorized to receive 0.5 days of Class "A" pay.
7. Corps / Squadron COs and supervisors are to ensure that all adult leaders who have not previously completed the PYDPO package do so as soon as possible and before the new deadlines.
8. Members are reminded that the DLN is currently planned to be shut down for a software update from 30 June to 18 July 2016. This period could be lengthened if technical issues occur. Members would be wise to complete the package in advance of this shut down in order to avoid unexpected circumstances from hindering their capacity to complete the package by the new deadlines. Last minute completions of the PYDPO in March 2016 were responsible for causing severe technical issues with the DLN further complicating members' ability to complete the training, and this practice should be avoided.
9. The broader integration of the PYDPO into the existing CCO personnel training program framework is currently being examined by the Natl CJCR Sp Gp.
10. A list of personnel who are not recorded as having completed the PYDPO is included as Annex A.

118/16 – NATIONAL CADET AND JUNIOR CANADIAN RANGER SUPPORT GROUP ORDERS

1. The current volumes of Cadet Administrative and Training Orders (CATO) will be replaced by National Cadet and Junior Canadian Ranger Support Group Orders (Natl CJCR Sp Gp Orders). These Gp Orders will start to be issued in the next few weeks, posted on the File Repository.
2. The Gp Orders will provide guidance with respect to Group policy and procedures on a wide range of matters relevant to operations and administration. They will be issued to supplement and amplify existing Orders and Regulations.
3. The current CATOs will be replaced or cancelled as the Gp Orders are issued. Those CATOs that have not been replaced or cancelled will remain in effect. RCSU (Pac) ROs will provide detail regarding the replacement or cancellation of CATOs and the issuance of Gp Orders. This transition to Gp Orders is expected to take place over the next several months.
4. The new Gp Orders will follow a new format which is intended to make them easier to reference. Gp Orders will be issued in both official languages; however, each language will be in a separate unilingual document.
5. As we transition to the Gp Orders, our Pacific Region Cadet Instructions (PRCIs) will be reviewed and either cancelled or updated as applicable.

119/16 – DUTY-RELATED INJURIES – COATS MEMBERS AND CADETS

1. COATS members on Class A or Class B Reserve Service who experience a duty-related medical or dental injury are reminded that if they require care beyond their period of service, they must contact the Regional Cadet Medical Liaison Officer (RCMLO) at RCSU (Pac). Any expenses related to care must be authorized in advance or the member may not be entitled to claim reimbursement.
2. In the same way, if a cadet is injured during a cadet training activity, there is limited entitlement to medical and dental care and pre-approval for any expenses is required. Therefore, if a cadet requires treatment following an injury suffered at a cadet training activity, the RCMLO at RCSU (Pac) must be contacted.
