Ref: 4500-3 (J5 Pers Trg Plans) 8 Mar 17

1. Ref memorandum was distributed to all corps and squadrons and the direction from the DComd Natl CJCR Sp Gp, Col J.G.D. Proteau, is summarized for emphasis below:

- a. there is a requirement for Canadian Cadet Organizations (CCO) adult leaders to complete the Positive Youth Development and Program Outreach (PYDPO) learning package;
- b. the PYDPO package is now a pre-requisite for members to attend any CIC Occupational, Job-Based or Specialty Training as well as to be employed at Cadet Training Centres (CTCs) / Regional Training Establishments (RTEs). Corps / squadron and RCSU personnel must ensure that members have completed the PYDPO prior to being nominated for training and/or employment. New enrollees are authorized to be nominated on the CIC Basic Officer Training Course (BOTC) Distance Learning (DL) phase and the CIC Occupational Training Course (OTC) DL phase, but will be required to complete the PYDPO prior to being nominated for the BOTC in-house phase;
- c. administrative actions shall be taken for any Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) member within the CCO who has failed to complete the PYDPO package within 6 months after the date they have been enrolled;
- d. CAF members who transfer to the Cadet Organizations Administration and Training Service (COATS) are required to complete the PYDPO prior to the completion of the transfer process;
- e. civilian instructors and civilian employees must complete this mandatory training requirement within 6 months of the date they joined the organization. Failure to

do so will entail the imposition of administrative actions which may lead to their involvement / employment being terminated. Civilian instructors and civilian employees will not receive pay for the completion of the PYDPO package;

- f. COATS members who joined the organization after 1 Jan 17 will receive pay for the completion of the PYDPO package. Based on a course review and updated courseware, COATS members are entitled to receive up to 2 days of Class A pay upon completion of the package. No pay entitlement exists for members who have been enrolled prior to this date; and
- g. Col Proteau orders that cadet corps/squadron Commanding Officers and Officers in Charge (OIC) of cadet / CIC RTEs to validate that their respective subordinates have completed this mandatory requirement.

“CAF members posted to or working within the Canadian Cadet Organization (CCO) will not provide aid in any official capacity without approval from the Comd Natl CJCR Sp Gp. As private citizens, Class A COATS personnel (i.e. members not working for CAF) may act in whatever manner they see is required. No CAF insurance coverage or benefits are provided in the event of injury.

Cadets are not members of the CAF, as such, they may act in any way they feel is appropriate to support their community. However, cadet units will not provide aid as a formal part of the CCO. Groups of *individuals* may support their community. I must stress the fact that providing support, such as filling/moving sandbags increases the risk of injury. As no approval has been given on the part of the cadet movement, an injury incurred while providing support to the flooding is in no way attributable to a cadet activity. In the event

individuals wish to take part in flood relief efforts, cadet uniforms shall not be worn.”

1. Ref A applies to all CAF officer, Reg and Res, who wear the Army uniform.
2. As part of phase three of ref B, a new metal rank star for CA officers was implemented in Apr 17 on officer service dress tunics.
3. There is no change to the crown metal rank badge or the star of the order of the garter rank badge currently worn by officers. This change to service dress tunic rank badges will not affect CadPat or ECU sloth slip-ons/patches, service dress cloth slip-ons, or mess dress rank badges which remain the same.
4. CA officers are to log in to their Logistik Unicorp Clothing on-line account to order the Vimy Star. Upon logging in, the system will detect that an entitled officer needs to order the new Vimy Star and will automatically add them to their cart based on the pre-determined scale of issue. The member then needs to complete the checkout process to have them shipped to their desired address.
5. At the current time, only gold Vimy Stars will be distributed through Logistik Unicorp, for Corps and Regiments who wear silver, black or gun-metal rank and accoutrements, Vimy Stars in these colours will be provided by Logistik Unicorp in the coming months. Individuals in these Corps and Regiments are to continue wearing their currently held accoutrements until Vimy Stars of the correct colour and quality are available through the supply system. Distribution details will be provided in a subsequent CANFORGEN.
6. CA officers may commence wearing the Vimy Star as soon as it is received. All CA officers who wear gold accoutrements are expected to wear the Vimy Star NLT 1 Sep 17.
